

FiberFusion 1000 Fiberglass Windows Wood Veneer Variation and Stain Disclaimer

The saying, "nature creates but never duplicates", captures the essence of wood. Just like our own personalities and fingerprints, each piece of wood has its own character. This variation give wood its beauty and explains why wood is so popular. However, it is important that you understand the nature and characteristics of the wood veneer and stain you have selected to be used on your FiberFusion 1000 windows and the factors that affect its appearance.

Color and Grain Variations

The wood veneer FiberFusion 1000 windows you purchase will contain some color and graining variations. Even within the same wood species, no two pieces of wood are identical. Variations in color tone and grain pattern make an exact color or pattern match to any given sample impossible. Although all of the wood veneer material will be from the same wood species, each will have varying grains and textures. This is not considered a defect, but merely a part of the natural beauty of wood. As a result, Armaclad Windows and Doors, LLC, its agents and representatives, cannot be responsible for color tone and graining variations in the wood veneer and stain that have been selected.

Stained Finishes

The beauty of our stained finished natural wood veneers come from the wood itself. During its growth, natural elements will affect the color, grain and texture, resulting in various shades in the wood. Because of the unique characteristics of wood, our two coat staining and clear coat sealing process enhances the inherent variations in color and graining, highlighting these qualities to create a truly beautiful product. While staining the wood veneers tends to blend these variations, it is important to be aware that various stains will further enhance the variations. This is why your finished FiberFusion 1000 windows may vary from the appearance represented by a small window sample or stain sample. As a result, Armaclad Windows and Doors, LLC, its agents and representatives, cannot be responsible for variations which may characterize your finished windows.

Aging and the Effect of Lighting

Other factors can affect the look of your windows, such as your homes lighting conditions. Over time, the color of the wood veneer you have selected for your windows will mellow. By this, we mean the color or tone may change. In some cases, like maple, it can lighten or develop a yellowish hue. Just like we take precautions to protect our skin from sunburn, Armaclad takes precautions to protect the wood veneers from UV rays. We use premium quality stains and finish coats with superior quality UV inhibitors available to preserve the color and life of the wood. Nature and natural light may age the wood to rich tones not present when your windows were first installed. This aging enhances the beauty and character of the product you have selected. Due to the effect of natural light on wood, Armaclad Windows and Doors, LLC, its agents and representatives cannot be responsible for variations in wood color and tone from the effects of UV lighting and the natural aging of wood.

Replacement Products

From time to time, products may arrive damaged or be damaged in the course of everyday life. It is very important to understand that the replaced part may not be an exact MATCH with the rest of the window(s), but will blend with the color.
